As you know, getting the right message out to your community of family, friends and neighbors is a big part of a successful campaign. Here are some tips for how to take and send a quality photo that will help us share your message of hope.



How to Take a Great Picture

Remembering a few important details can make a BIG difference! They can turn a good picture into a great picture.

1. Grab a camera! (just not the one on your cell phone)
2. Pick a spot! The photo background should be simple and uncluttered, but do avoid the plain white wall look! If you are taking a picture inside, sitting in a nice chair by a fireplace or a plant gives a soft background that's not too busy.
3. Smile! Everyone likes to look their best in a photo, and that's important even though you may not feel your best. Remember to smile.
4. If you would rather send in a photo that you already have on hand, that will work, too, as long as the photo is not more than two years old.

Sending NFT your Photo

Film versus Digital: Either one will work great! Whatever kind of camera you have available will work, but remember these helpful hints:

- If your photo is taken with a Film-type Camera:
 1. Process the film and send us an original print in the mail.
 2. Do not scan the photo and print it out at home for us. We will have to scan it again, and this will not produce a quality photo.
 3. If you scan the photo to send digitally, be sure to scan on a high resolution of 300 dpi, or the largest setting possible. Please do not crop the photo before sending, as that changes the quality.
- If your photo is taken with a Digital Camera:
 1. How easy! **Save the photo in your computer in a .jpg or .tif format.**
 2. Name the photo file with your name.
 3. Email it to your fundraising consultant.



** Please do not send copyrighted photos. (Most professional photographers prohibit use of their photos – this includes photos taken at studios, department stores, etc.)
